Good Morning,

Aren't we lucky here in the UK? We've recently had seven marvellous Elvis Concerts accompanied by the Royal Philharmonic Concert Orchestra performed in some of the UK's largest arenas. Let's just think about that for a moment. Here we have Elvis performing on a huge screen in super-high definition and unbelievable sound clarity with a proper full-sized orchestra playing their hearts out below...and with side screens picking out the individual players and backing singers – and their dance routines! - just to add even more to the show. Few concerts for living artistes give us as much and certainly don't have the atmosphere that these can offer. It proves what an incredible showman Elvis was and, through this type of concert, still is. Why am I asking why we're so lucky? Well, it's simply because we, here in the UK, are the only fans to have had this show. It hasn't been performed anywhere else and probably won't be. It was done for us, not the fans in Brazil, or Australia, or even the USA, many of whom being just as loyal to 'our man' as we are but clearly the incredible cost of taking a show such as this 'on the road' would demand more fans in any one place than the other nations could muster. So it comes to the UK where EPE and the promoters know that we won't let them - or Elvis of course - down.

And now we also have the 'Direct from Graceland' Elvis Exhibition at the new Arches London Bridge venue alongside London Bridge Station in the heart of the city. This is



the first Exhibition to be held in this venue – itself an amazing amalgamation of cavernous railway arches, brilliantly modernised and ideal for a 'get up close' collection of Elvis artifacts that will take your breath away. The Exhibition lasts only until 25th February so don't miss it. Unlike the Concert it wouldn't be viable to take this around the UK so it has to stay in one place and I realise that travel can be expensive but check-out National Express who can offer really good rates on a London Day Return. And this Exhibition too is heading back to Graceland after it finishes in London – not available elsewhere.



I'm delighted to say that we at Strictly Elvis UK/Elvis Travel Service are always ready to help overseas fans and so, combining the Elvis Concert at the O2 on 31st October and the Direct from Graceland Exhibition on 1st November, we were delighted to arrange the visits of coachloads of fans from France and Belgium – lovely people and brought together with us by a combined love of Elvis making it an international occasion. Oh yes, that's another reason we're so lucky.

I felt the Festival had a fabulous vibe about it this year, everyone dancing with smiling faces, amazing bands playing a variety of music from Rock 'n' Roll to Soul, and Linda Gail Lewis playing brother Jerry Lee's biggest hits. Also enjoying the many wonderful hours of pure, unadulterated Elvis tunes loved and played by the very best Elvis DJ's keeping the dancefloor full.

There were lots of fun events, competitions, talks by Donna Presley and Alanna Nash, both extremely fascinating to listen to with their own Elvis related stories. There were also daily dance classes where we could learn to jive and stroll and then bring those new skills to the dancefloors in the evenings.

The sun shone for us all at the Hawaiian patio party which was a riot of colour, music and laughter with members of the team entertaining everyone with funny little dances, costumes and even bongos!!

It also did my heart good to see all the fabulous ways in which we, as the Elvis Family, were giving back and raising money for so many wonderful charitable causes, just as Elvis himself did in his never-ending philanthropic way.

In need of some retail therapy? Then you could hardly be in a better place for treatment. The big-name stores of Bournemouth's city centre are just a few minutes from the hotel and there's certainly no shortage of shops...department stores, boutiques, speciality emporiums and the obligatory multitude of coffee shops are all there, but if you are looking for quaintness, individuality, retro, antiques, nautical or just plain quirky then you're sure to find something special along the lanes around Poole Quay, in the nearby coastal villages of Southbourne, Boscombe, Westbourne (which has an exquisite Victorian Arcade) or the nearby town of Christchurch.

Feeling peckish — well that's more than taken care of by the vast array of eateries. Whilst breakfast and dinner are included in this special break you could of course also have lunch in the hotel but isn't it tempting to have it at Rick Stein's Sandbanks restaurant or perhaps enjoy fish'n'chips followed by an ice cream on the seafront? IF EVERY DAY WAS LIKE CHRISTMAS

If you ask Elvis fans what they thought Elvis' favourite time of year was, many would say 'Christmas'.

Elvis' first Christmas at Graceland was in 1957 and on 12th December of that year Elvis purchased a giant Santa and sleigh decoration for the grounds of Graceland, it read, "Merry Christmas to All, Elvis" it seems Elvis wanted to share his seasonal cheer with all of his fans.

In 1965, Elvis was once again preparing for Christmas celebrations by leasing a Nativity scene for the front lawn of Graceland, this ornate structure certainly came at a cost, at \$1,140 for the first year's rental alone. The original handpainted fiberglass Nativity scene served as the backdrop for Elvis and Priscilla's 1965 Christmas card. The Nativity stable measured 15 feet wide and included nine figurines - those of Mother Mary, Joseph, baby Jesus in a manger, three wise men, one shepherd, one angel and one calf's head. Whilst it was certainly a hugely impressive scene, Elvis asked for the angel that hung above the Holy Family to be removed from the structure shortly after its debut because he thought the figurine was too shapely and inappropriate for a religious representation! When the company that Elvis, and eventually Graceland, leased the Nativity scenes from went out of business, Graceland purchased the displays to ensure the continuation of Elvis' holiday tradition and they are on display each Christmas to this day.

Over the years Elvis continued to add Christmas decorations to the Graceland grounds and had seen an impressive California home with a decorated blue light driveway, Elvis put a call into Vernon to purchase similar lights ahead of the Christmas celebrations, Vernon was dubious, however he went ahead and sourced a large supply of the vivid blue lights and arranged for them to be fitted along Graceland's extensive driveway, Vernon could be heard joking that one day, he'd wake up and find an airplane parked on the driveway due to its resemblance of a runway and its close proximity to Memphis Airport.

Elvis not only organised the decorating of the exterior of Graceland but gave the same care and attention to the interior. He displayed two Christmas trees in his home, a white in the sitting room and a green in the dining room, the original baubles and tinsel that belonged to the Presley's are still used and are carefully packed way each year in readiness for the following Christmas. We are fortunate to have so many photos of Elvis at Graceland at Christmas, obviously enjoying the celebrations and doing what Elvis is known for best, the giving of gifts and presents.

Graceland maintains the tradition of decorating the house and grounds and for keeping them in place until after Elvis' Birthday on 8th January and whilst we know that Graceland looks wonderful at any time of year it's Christmas sparkle is certainly a sight to see.

The new multi-million pound exhibition space Arches London Bridge decided that when they opened, they were going to make their inaugural event a big one – and there's no bigger draw than Elvis!

'Direct From Graceland' is another chance to get up close to personal Elvis artefacts (over 400!) with cars, jumpsuits, on-stage and off-stage clothing, jewellery and so much more in this jam-packed display of a veritable treasure trove of items from the Graceland archives.

Amongst the iconic pieces there are some favourites which have previously been seen on these shores at the Elvis at the O2 exhibits but with many new artefacts (particularly wonderful, and poignant, are the personal items of Gladys and Lisa Marie) making their debut appearances in the UK – along with a real bonus for us Brits, an item that has never been on display anywhere else before!

'Direct From Graceland' is also offering a premium ticket, with the opportunity to handle, and have photos taken with, two iconic Elvis items from the 70's; his famous and much loved belt awarded after his run of sell-out shows in Las Vegas in 1969, along with a gold microphone also used for his engagements in the city that is synonymous with Elvis.

From the vulnerability of his early years in Tupelo to the raw talent of the 50's and the powerhouse of the silver screen all the way to the majesty of his 70's touring years, there are displays and items relating to all of the stages of Elvis' incredible life and career, including those that peek behind the public image shedding light on the private life of Elvis too. 
